





2023 CMA TRIALS NATIONALS Rounds 1 and 2 Notre-Dame-du-Portage, QC September 30th and October 1st

CMA sanctioned event hosted by l'Association des Trialistes Amateurs du Québec

Shortcuts to complete your registration:

- 1. Get a CMA membership (required if you want your score to count for the national championship)
- 2. Get an FQMHR membership (Free MANDATORY)
- 3. Register online for the round(s)

→ 1. CMA Membership:

It is required to be a CMA competition member in order to have your position accounted towards the National Championships. CMA Competition memberships costs 45\$ if done AFTER Sept. 1st

CLASSES: EXPERT, ADVANCED, INTERMEDIATE, VETERAN (45+), SUPER VETERAN (55+), JUNIOR, NOVICE, YOUTH

Here's a guide for ATAQ riders on which class they would typically register for these rounds:

CMA National Class	ATAQ Class	Arrows / Line color
EXPERT	Expert	Red
ADVANCED	S1	Green w/ Red Splits
INTER	S2	Green
VETERAN 45+	S2	Green
SUPER VET 55+	S3	Blue
JUNIOR	S3	Blue
NOVICE	S4	White
YOUTH	S5	

Riders fitting in the age categories of 45 and + can choose to ride Veteran to be ranked with peers of their age, but are not forced to do so (other classes remain open to them if the level of difficulty suits them better). Similarly, riders fitting in the age category of 55 and + can choose to ride Super-Veteran or not.

Youth sections will be grouped together and separated from the rest where access is easy for the young riders.

Note: There will be no points counting towards the ATAQ provincial championship during these two rounds.

→ 2. FQMHR Membership:

Fédération Québécoise des Motos Hors Route (FQMHR) membership is mandatory for ALL riders.

This is <u>free of charge</u> and required for insurance purpose. The registration is done online and membership number generated immediately.

If you are not a member already, here's how to register:

- 1. Go to https://www.fgmhr.qc.ca/en/zone membre.php
- 2. Click on "Become a member"
- 3. Enter your email address and click on "Create a new account"
- 4. Fill the form with your information and click on Save
- 5. Go back to https://www.fqmhr.qc.ca/en/zone_membre.php
- 6. Click on "ALREADY A MEMBER!", enter your email and password chosen in previous steps below "I ALREADY HAVE AN ACCOUNT" and Click on Log In
- 7. Click on Join In in the blue rectangle "Recreational park Motorcyclist member"
- 8. Under Membership category, select: "Membre parc récréatif"
- 9. At the bottom of the form, double check your first and last name and click on "Join In"
- 10. An invoice with 0.00\$ fee should show
- 11. Click on "I have read and accepted the refund policy" and "I have signed the risk acknowledgment and acceptance form"
- 12. Click on "Send"
- 13. Click on "Imprimer la carte"
- 14. Click the printer icon to print your card on your printer or save a screenshot of the card.
- 15. You should receive an email as well with a link to print the card.
- 16. May you have lost the email or want to print or view the card at a later time, repeat step #6 and once logged in, simply click on "Imprimer votre carte" showing in the blue rectangle.

Important! You'll need to present either a copy of screenshot of your FQMHR card when registering at the ATAQ booth the day of competition.

→ 3. Competition Registration:

The registration is done online on via a payment platform on the ATAQ website. Links below.

Please complete your FQMHR registration (previous page) prior to registering to the events as you'll need to input your FQMHR number.

Fees:

Adult (18 years old and up) = 45\$ per day

Youth (17 years old and less) = 15\$ per day

Important! Registrations done after September 25th will have 15\$ late/extra fee per day.

Rules:

- CMA Rules to apply with the exception of the number plate requirements. Color-coded stickers will be given to apply on your front plate to identify your riding line.
- Back protection highly recommended but not mandatory for this one event.
- Reminder: as per CMA and ATAQ rules, a cut-off switch, connected through a lanyard to the rider is required.
- Covered sprocket required as per ATAQ rule. A sticker for that purpose will be given for those requiring. Thanks for TREQMOTO for supplying this.

- Only a portable chemical toilet will be available
- FREE in all cases.
